Public Invited to Take Part in Regional Airport Master Planning Process

Wichita Falls, Texas- The City of Wichita Falls is inviting the public to provide input into the upcoming Regional Airport's Master Planning process on Monday, October 16, 2023, at 4000 Armstrong Drive from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

It has been 15 years since the last master plan was completed, and the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has requested that the City of Wichita Falls update its master plan to address projects for the next 15-year planning cycle.

The public is invited to provide feedback regarding the Airport, as well as what they would like to see in the future moving forward, and future development for consideration as a part of the master planning process.

The main parking lot will be open for those wanting to attend, and there will be no charge to park.

The FAA will pay for 90% of the planning project cost, and the 4A Wichita Falls Economic Development Board has committed to pay for the City's 10% local match requirements.

Through partnerships with the FAA, 4A, and 4B Economic Development Corporations, over \$55 million in improvements have been made at Wichita Falls Regional Airport since 2009.
